# Outline of the Local Government Exchange and Cooperation Seminar 2017 (CLAIR SYDNEY)

#### 1. Program Overview

The Local Government Exchange and Cooperation Seminar (hereinafter referred to as "the Seminar") is hosted by the Council of Local Authorities for International Relations (CLAIR). The goal of the Seminar is to build networks and promote mutual understanding between the local governments in Japan and overseas.

The Seminar consists of two parts: the Tokyo Seminar and Local Authority Exchange Program. At the Tokyo Seminar, participants will learn about the overall Japanese local government system through a lecture and go on inspection of public facilities and tourist attractions. After the Tokyo Seminar, participants will travel to a host local authority. Based on the theme of the seminar, participants will engage in opinion exchange with the host local authority, learn about the relevant issues through inspection, and experience local Japanese culture through site visits and homestay.

## 4. Eligible Participants

Eligible participants should be residents of countries covered by CLAIR Sydney\*. They must also be local government executives or executives involved in regional promotion or international exchange. In addition, applicants from national organizations, research institutes, or other related organizations may be eligible to participate, providing their backgrounds are related to the theme of the Seminar. The Director of CLAIR Sydney will make the final decision regarding eligibility. <u>Up to 5</u> participants will be selected.

## 5. Schedule

The Seminar will be held from <u>12-21 February 2018</u>. Participants will arrive in Tokyo, then travel to <u>Higashine City (Yamagata Prefecture)</u>, the host local authority.

- Personal expenses incurred in Japan (e.g. shopping, phone calls, food/drinks from hotel mini-bars, expenses incurred in free time)
